Automated download of email attachments from any specified folder in Microsoft Outlook.

How to Configure

1. In studio, inside your process drag and drop microbot activity from the process components in flowchart, and then select the imported microbot.
2. Click Settings, and then click Input/Output Parameter Mapping for the respective microbot.
3. Configure the input/output parameters by creating the arguments in automation studio with respect to the parameters as mentioned below.

KEY	Direction	Description	Sample Value
AttachmentFilePath	Input	It is the complete path where downloaded attachments need to be saved.	Ex.: "D:/Input"
NameOfTheFolder	Input	It is the name of the folder in outlook, from where we want to download attachment	Ex.- "Inbox"
Subject	Input	The subject of the mail contains in the inbox mail	Ex. -- "Notebook Distribution Drive 2019"
OnlyUnread	Input	User can enter value either true or false. It depends on read or unread mails attachments user wants to download.	Ex. – if user wants to download the attachment from already read mails then it is set as "true". Also if user wants to download attachment from unread mails then it is set as "false"
SenderEmailAddress	Input	The Email address of the sender whose attachment user want to download	Ex.: abc.def@Infosys.com
MailRecievedDate	Input	The received date of the mail, whose attachment user want to download	Ex.= DateTime.Parse("6/28/2019")

ErrCode	Output	Error code	Ex.-100
ErrDesc	Output	Error Description	Ex.- System Define Exception
IsSuccess	Output	IS Successful execution	(True\False)
OutputMessage	Output	If at the end of execution, the microbot successfully download the attachment from outlook then this parameter hold the output message.	
MailCount	Output	Based on the input parameters values, if the mail found in given folder means, it will return count of the mail.	
AttachmentCount	Output	Downloaded attachment count	

4. Use the output variable in your subsequent processing.
5. Click save option, then at the top-right, click Test run.
6. Upon successful test, the skill is ready to run application.

Error Code

- 100 – System Define Exception.
- 101 Please provide any one or multiple combination of the Subject, SenderEmailAddress, MailReceivedDate input values.
- 102 - Attachment file path is empty
- 103 - Name of the folder is empty.
- 104 - Path doesn't exist.
- 105 – Attachment not found.
- 106 – Mail not found.
