How to Configure

- 1. In studio, import the process BOT into flowchart.
- 2. Configure the input/output parameters by creating the arguments in automation studio with respect to the parameters as mentioned below.

SenderMailID	SenderID is the sender's mail ID	abc@xyz.com
ToMailID	ToID is the receiver's mail ID	abc@xyz.com
CCID	CCID is the CC to be marked in the mail	abc@xyz.com
BCCID	BCCID is the BCC to be marked in the mail	abc@xyz.com
Profilename	ProfileName is the profile name in outlook	Outlook
Subjectline	Subjectline is the subject in the mail	xxx
Imagepath	ImagePath is the location where the image is placed	D:\SendMailwithimageinbody\XXX.png
ImageinBodycontent	ImageinBodycontent is the size of the image, it can be increased/decreased	

- 3. Use the output variable in your subsequent processing
- 4. Click save option, then at the top-right, click Test run.
- 5. Upon successful test, the skill is ready to run application.
